SCHOOL ESSENTIALS

UNIFORM

ATTENDANCE AND PUNCTUALITY

Punctuality is getting better—thank you for your support with this. It so important that children are here on time so they have the best possible start to the day. The first minutes of the school day are crucial in all year groups. Please continue to ensure children are here on time—gates open at 8.45am
